#### Dear Friends in Christ,



I have been sitting here staring at the computer screen for well over an hour and nothing has happened. Christmas music is playing in the background coming from the "Sounds of the Seasons: Holidays" cable channel with the familiar songs doing little more than filling a disturbing and unsettling quiet. There is an obvious and uncomfortable disconnect between my mind, my heart, and ultimately my fingers resting on the keyboard. The task before me is to write a pastor's message for the December "Encourager".....nothing! Then, I looked at an unopened piece of mail from the Duke Divinity School laying on my desk which simply had the words "Meditations for ADVENT" on the front.

Each year as the Advent/Christmas season approaches I receive this little booklet of meditations from the Divinity School with brief devotionals for each of the Sundays of Advent as well as one for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. They are written by both faculty and students at the Divinity School. I opened this year's booklet, and the first words I focus on is the "Introduction" written by Elaine Heath, Dean of the Divinity School and Professor of Missional and Pastoral Theology. Her words immediately hit home and were exactly what I needed to hear in this moment in time. I call this a "God-thing"....God providing just what we need, when we need it. So, now I write!

She began by saying, "These are perilous times." She went on to talk about some of the times that we have been living through in these past few months. She spoke of devastating hurricanes that literally flattened entire islands and communities. She spoke of millions of acres burned to ashes as a result of one of the worst wildfire seasons in our history. Spoke of how our nation and the world faces a grave risk of thermonuclear war. Add to all of this there are fresh memories of mass shootings where far too many innocent people were gunned down and either injured or killed and certainly even more lives forever changed. There is certainly no shortage of these "perilous times". Then....add to all of this the "perilous times" of our own lives like serious health issues, the death of loved ones, the loss of a job or financial resources just not stretching far enough, broken relationships, addiction, depression, anxiety, and so much more. Ms Heath uses the word chaos, and I would add the word darkness!

She writes: "Amidst the fearsome chaos all around us we remember that Advent is the season of longing for the Light. Each day as we journey toward Bethlehem we bring the devastation (and, I would add darkness) with us, wailing the sorrows and needs of the world (again, I would add our world). "How long, O Lord?" we cry. "If only you would tear open the heavens and come down!" (Isaiah 64:1a).

"So it is that we work our way to the Christ Child, the answer to our prayer. He sleeps in a feed trough, surrounded by the sounds and smells of cattle. His mother is too young, too vulnerable, too poor. There are rumblings from the government that new trouble is on its way. The babe will soon be a refugee.

"The Lord *did* tear open the heavens. The Lord *did* come down. Salvation *is* upon us, but not in the way we hoped.

"So it is that with Isaiah we lift a prayer of lament and confession. "Forgive us, O Lord, for demanding a violent God who would crush our enemies but show favor to us. Forgive us for the sin of our presumption. May the wisdom of Christ be in us and guide us into a new day. May we bear witness to Christ through our own incarnation of his love, solidarity, and forgiveness. Amen."

I pray that for each and everyone of us that this year's Advent/Christmas season is one that does not dwell on the chaos of our lives but instead on the Light of Christ in the darkness, Light that is a reminder to us of the real gifts of the season: hope, peace, joy, and love, gifts when embraced in faith will indeed empower us to bear witness to Jesus Christ through living our lives by his example of his love, grace, mercy, and forgiveness. This Advent/Christmas, I urge each of us to take a step of faith away from our world of chaos and into a way of life....His way of life....that will change us, and through us, change the world, our world!

I hope this is truly a season blessed in Christ's presence and changed by His love!

PS....I want to share part of a poem/prayer: "An anxious note to baby Jesus" written by Peter Thurston

Dear Lord,

All begun in makeshift circumstances. (Sorry, Lord, we were not better prepared – some things didn't change.)

A sign of things to come, of an uphill struggle to make your voice heard.

Uphill towards Jerusalem.

Uphill to the Mount of Olives.

Uphill to the hill of execution.

Hoping we would follow.

Hoping we would understand you, respond to you, welcome you then, welcome you now.

Or was your love your inner energy, the love you received your support, the love you gave a light in the darkness, the love you give the strength I need?

Will you help me though Advent, dear Lord, little one?

Give me the grace to greet you without suppressed sighs of weariness. Give me the generosity to invite you home without thought to the inconvenience. Give me the will to rise to your demands, to share your love and to receive it.

It's not so much to ask, I know, when you have faced it all – the Advent task, the Christmas hope – two thousand times before.


