

Raise Money For First UMC of Seffner When You Use *H&R Block* To Do Your Taxes

H&R Block will donate \$20 for every new client we refer. Pam Hill, who works for H&R Block preparing tax returns, signs our church up for the Referral program every year, which has brought in \$3,490.00 for our church over the past eight years.
