Children's Welcome

Dear Families,

Teaching children about God is my calling. Ever since I was young I desired to be a teacher. As I got older the way I thought I was to teach children changed. Instead of teaching in an elementary school, God helped pave a way for me to teach children about Him at my home day care and at church.

I started attending First UMC of Seffner when I was 12. I began in Darryl and Zoila Walter's Junior High Sunday School class. We met where the youth room is now, actually one side of it because there was once a wall and there were two classes there. When my family began attending we were still in the old sanctuary. I also remember Wayne Allen as my High School Sunday School teacher who shared with us a book about positive thinking. I believe this has helped me see the glass as half full and not half empty.

After I graduated from high school I worked at Younger Years Day Care teaching preschoolers. I also helped on Wednesday nights at church with Pioneer Club. After this dissolved I stepped back from helping out at church until I had kids of my own.

Slowly, I began directing the children's plays and helping out at Vacation Bible Schools. I even was able to bring my day care kids to participate.

After my Walk to Emmaus in 2000, I realized that God was calling me to be a Children's Minister. I coordinated and served in Children's church and ministered to the kids here (one of them being Daniel Williams). I was able to serve as Seffner's Children's Minister until 2006 when Brian accepted his call as a pastor over at Port Tampa UMC where I served as Children's Minister there. I was excited to come back and prayed for the opportunity to be able to serve again.

Praise God, the opportunity to serve as Children's Minister has happened! I just recently finished up a program giving me a certificate in children's ministry. I believe it is important to teach the children how much God loves each one of them which is something I strive to do daily at my home daycare. One of our favorite sayings is, "It's alright if I messed up, God still loves me."

Beginning November 1st, I plan to begin Children's church. This is a unique service for children to be able to sing songs and hear a message that is geared to their level and opening their hearts to Jesus. Of course with the concern of Covid, family siblings will be together while distanced from other families until such a time as we can just come together in the name of Jesus.

Of course, the most important people to guide your children to follow Christ is you since church is only a small part in the hours of a week, but a big part in serving God. I hope I can help you guide your children on this journey of life.
