In The Quiet Place

"Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations,

I will be exalted in the earth!" Psalm 46:10

The barking comes in the middle of the night, the quiet is gone and slumber is hard. The revving of the motorcycle engine next door, over and over, the quiet is gone. The early mornings as Diana awaits the children to arrive, then one by one they enter in each a buddle full of energy, the quiet is gone. Just when you begin to drift off to sleep and the phone rings, the quiet is gone.

There are days when we wondered will we have a chance to just sit and gather our thoughts. The excitement of Easter has just passed us, but did you know we are Easter people? 






Women's Bible Study


